

## New Fitness Trail Coming to Kiwanis Recreation Park!

The City of Painesville has partnered with Lubrizol and the Painesville City Local Schools to create a new fitness trail at Kiwanis Recreation Park. The project has come together as part of Lubrizol's 60th anniversary. For their part Lubrizol wanted to do something special for the Painesville Community for their support over the past 60 years, as well as create additional fitness opportunities for their employees to enjoy. The Painesville City Schools Wellness Program was also interested in creating more fitness opportunities for their employees and the community as a whole. The City's Department of Recreation and Public Lands was able to get everyone to the table to create one project to meet everyone's goals!

The trail will include 5 fitness stations strategically placed along the 1/2 mile Riverwalk Trail at Kiwanis Recreation Park. Users will get to enjoy a horizontal ladder with balance beam, push-up/triceps station, parallel bars, pull-up/chin-up station, and a 3-sided station with a variety of exercises to do (pictured below), in addition to the beautiful scenery along the way! The approximate cost of the project is \$30,000. This is a great addition to an already incredible park. Installation is scheduled to be completed by the fall.

With this new trail, combined with Disc Golf, DEK Hockey, a fishing pond, fishing on the Grand River, a skate park, and more Kiwanis Recreation Park is truly a destination park here in the Lake County area.

## COMMUNITY REMINDERS

- **Fall Clean-Up at Evergreen and Riverside Cemeteries** will occur from October 1st through November 15th. No decoration of any kind will be permitted during these scheduled cleaning months, except Halloween decorations. Halloween decorations will be permitted five (5) days prior to October 31st and must be removed five (5) days after. Any decorations not removed by November 5th will be discarded by Cemetery personnel.
- **SIDEWALK PLOW PREPARATION** City employees will be preparing for the upcoming snow removal season by going over the sidewalk plowing routes and removing low hanging limbs and brush that may interfere with the sidewalk plows. If any resident would like to put out stakes to designate sidewalks, please feel free to do so. Please keep in mind that sidewalks will be plowed when there is 4" or more of snow. Please make sure vehicles parked in driveways do not block the sidewalks. Thank you so much for your cooperation in allowing us to provide the best City services possible.
- The City's "snow parking ban" goes into effect when snow amounts exceed 2".
- When traveling City streets during a snow event, slow down and keep a clear distance from plow trucks and snow removal equipment.
- Beginning October 1st, the City of Painesville Electric Department is offering **home energy audits**. A team of auditors from the Electric Plant will come to your home to evaluate energy usage and make recommendations to help you save on your energy bills. Call the Electric Plant at 440-392-5954 for more details.
- Are you planning some last minute house repairs before winter sets in? Be sure to call the City of Painesville Building Department to see if a permit is needed! Building Permits ensure the safety and welfare of the occupants.


