

**RESOLUTION NO. 27-16**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) TO PERFORM BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That the City Manager has determined the need for the described project in order for the City of Painesville to achieve full compliance with the Federal Highway Administration's bridge metrics: Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to bridge load rating calculations, scour assessments, bridge inspections, and fracture critical plan development.

SECTION II: Being in the public interest, the City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the ODOT Director of Transportation to complete the above described project known as Bridge Inspection Program Services.

SECTION III: The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract (Exhibit A).

The City of Painesville agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in Exhibit A.

SECTION IV: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to be in compliance with all applicable Federal Highway Administration bridge metrics, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
