

RESOLUTION NO. 28-16

A RESOLUTION HIRING MONICA S. IRELAN AS CITY MANAGER AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL WHICH ESTABLISHES THE TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville is a Council-Manager form of government; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to hire a City Manager pursuant to the provision of Article IV, Section I of the Charter of the City of Painesville; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that Monica S. Irelan meets the requirements and possesses the skills necessary to perform the duties of City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to hire Ms. Irelan effective December 12, 2016 under the terms and conditions described in the City Manager Employment Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Monica S. Irelan to serve as the City Manager of Painesville, Ohio.


SECTION 2. That effective December 12, 2016, Monica S. Irelan shall be appointed to the position of City Manager of the City of Painesville for a three (3) year term at a starting annual salary of \$115,000.

SECTION 3. That for purposes of vacation accrual Ms. Irelan's previous public service time shall be acknowledged and effective December 12, 2016 and Ms. Irelan shall receive two (2) weeks vacation upon hire during her first year of employment and may transfer any unused and unpaid vacation leave from her previous employer.

SECTION 4. That Ms. Irelan shall receive credit for previous accumulated unused sick leave and Ms. Irelan's previous public service time shall be considered time employed by the City of Painesville.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservations of the peach, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the continuance of the daily activities of the municipal operation and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective December 12, 2016.
