PAINESVILLE CITY COUNCIL INVITES RESIDENTS TO APPLY FOR POSITION OPENING ON THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

Painesville, OH – Painesville City Council invites City residents to submit letters of interest for a position on the Civil Service Commission. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 124.40 and City Charter Article XI, Section 1, the Civil Service Commission is comprised of three (3) electors of the City not holding any other municipal office or employment by the City, each of whom are appointed by Council for a term of six (6) years. The Civil Service Commission supervises and grades examinations for the hiring and promotion of Fire and Police Civil Service personnel, and serves as a Board of Review for Civil Service Classified Personnel. Meetings are held the first Thursday of the month on a quarterly basis (January, April, July, and October). They also meet on call for special circumstances. ***This position is filling an unexpired term and will require commitment through December 31, 2021.***
