

ORDINANCE NO. 05-16

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF
MATHEWS STREET CONTAINING
APPROXIMATELY 0.43 ACRES OF LAND and
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a request by Cashen Ready Mix, owner(s) of the property adjacent to a 0.43 acre portion of Mathews Street located south of the CSX Railroad and north of West Prospect Street hereinafter described, was presented to Council requesting that said described portion of Mathews Street be vacated; and

WHEREAS, City Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as requested; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and is no longer needed for municipal purposes, and ought to be made.

WHEREAS, the request was submitted to the Painesville City Planning Commission and approved by that body on 10th day of March, 2016, by a vote of 5-0 and therefore forwarded to this Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio that:

SECTION I. That a portion of Mathews Street property containing 0.43 acres in area portion of Mathews Street located south CSX Railroad and north of West Prospect Street is vacated as outlined on the plat identified as Vacation Plat of Part of Mathews Street:

SECTION II. That this Ordinance is adopted as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of at the City of Painesville, the emergency being that unnecessary delay will adversely affect the proper and effective development of the area of the City of Painesville, and therefore, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
