Our Detectives have been working diligently with the other agencies and arrested suspects in September to connect them to many of our burglaries. As you will notice, last month we spiked with 22 burglaries reported. We have had increased undercover / unmarked CITE team patrols. I as well as the administrative Sergeant have been spending several hours a day patrolling the neighborhoods, unmarked. We are still having day time burglaries. We dropped to 16 burglaries for this month, but with all the work and surveillance, I had hoped to bring that number even lower. We will keep up the extra patrols as long as my budget will permit and have every intention on catching more suspects. We currently have several leads on several suspects and hope several of these cases will be solved soon.
