Denise Coursen resigned to take a job with Madison Twp. Dispatch. Her police clerk vacancy provided the opportunity to restructure office duties. Barry Crowley was hired as a pull time Community Service Officer. Barry will be assigned to dayshift, assisting with overflow clerk duties, available to community events and to help out with court details. This flexibility will benefit the department more than replacing the clerk vacancy.

Two Sergeants (Miller and Burgett) and I attended free "Dealing with the Media" training held at Lakeland Community College. The course was taught by Bruce Henne. We were provided four hours of instruction on how to talk to the media and how best to present yourself and your message.

Sgt. Armstrong and Sgt. Miller began attending (PEALS) Police Executive Administrative Leadership training. These sergeants will attend one week a month for 3 months. The training is college level accredited requiring three research papers. Again this month, the department was able to send two of the officers to The Cuyahoga Coroners free Class on Death Investigations. This is still a free class offered to local police agencies to keep abreast on current death investigations.

Police department with the assistance of the Lake County Narcotics Agency served three search warrants this month. 8 E. South, 218 E. Prospect and 258 S. St. Clair St. were all raided. There were no officer or civilian injuries. Weapons, cash and narcotics were seized.
