Training – Sgt. Burgett attended the L.E.A.D.S. T.A.C. (Law Enforcement Automated Data System Terminal Area Coordinator) school in Columbus Ohio. This schooling was needed as he is to become the Assistant, for the department. Our Three Detectives attending a practical search warrant class in Richfield Ohio. Three officers and one detective attended an evidence collection refresher course at Mentor Police Department taught by Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations. Two officers attended an Arrest Search and Seizure course in Richfield Ohio. One Officer completed a Counter Combat Instructor course in London Ohio Police Officers Training Academy as part of his required training for becoming a Painesville Police self- defense instructor.

With respect to the continued pressure on our overtime budget, which is below what the department had available in 1999, and approximately 2000 less citizens, I have been left with the difficult task of cutting minimum manpower for each shift. Minimums will be reduced as follows beginning March 1<sup>st</sup>: Afternoon and Midnight Shifts will be 5 officers every day instead of 5 for weekdays and 6 on weekends. Dayshift will be reduced to 4 officers every day instead of 5 every day. These minimums reflect the minimums which were in effect prior to 2006, at a time when the department was working with manpower levels where they currently sit. In addition to these measures I am requesting to use the Cite Team Budget to help shore up our Regular OT Budget.
