

RESOLUTION NO. 3-13


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY
AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE
PURCHASE AND INSTALLTION OF A CARBON FEED
SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE
COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and is herby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for purchase and installation of a Carbon Feed System in accordance with specifications that will be placed on file in the office of the City Manager.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and for the customers in Painesville Township and Concord Township served by our water system, the emergency being the immediate necessity to effectively remove metals and organic materials (algae) from the water system; therefore this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon its passage.
