


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH STATEWIDE FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE CRUISERS AT A TOTAL COST OF \$52,924.00 FOR THE POLICE DIVISION, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY UNDER THE OHIO STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Statewide Ford for the purchase of two Police Cruisers at a total cost of \$52,924.00 for the Police Division, Department of Public Safety under the Ohio State Cooperative Purchasing Program, in accordance with the City of Painesville agreement with the State of Ohio for Cooperative Purchasing, authorized by Ordinance No. 14-86.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to purchase vehicles authorized in the 2010 annual Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. 28-09 and which are a part of a scheduled vehicle replacement program in this department, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
