


RESOLUTION NO. 6-15

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A RAW WATER INTAKE WATERLINE AND CRIB STRUCTURE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for the installation of a new raw water intake waterline and crib structure, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.


SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and all its customers. The resolution will ensure the Painesville Water Division can draw a consistent supply of raw water from Lake Erie and provide an alternate water source during Harmful Algae Blooms. Therefore this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon its passage.
