

RESOLUTION NO. 8-13


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER(S), TO INCLUDE ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR (4) DISTRIBUTION CIRCUITS LEAVING THE NORTHRIDGE SUBSTATION AND CONNECTING TO EXISTING PAINESVILLE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION CIRCUITS, FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That the City Manger be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder(s), to include any and all ensuing change orders, for the construction of four (4) distribution circuits leaving the Northridge substation and connecting to existing Painesville Municipal Electric circuits, for improvements to the City of Painesville Municipal Electric System, in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the City Manager.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the necessity to add distribution circuits for the new substation to improve the City of Painesville's Electric System reliability, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
