

RESOLUTION NO. 9-10

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE GRANT FROM
THE CLEAN OHIO REVITALIZATION FUND
(CORF) RELATED TO THE LAKE EAST HOSPITAL
PROJECT and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville submitted an initial application on July 29, 2009 to the Clean Ohio Council for funds to cleanup or remediate hazardous substances and/or petroleum at the Lake East Hospital site;

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2009 the Clean Ohio Council approved the City of Painesville's application to provide assistance in the amount of Two Million Fifty Two Thousand Four Hundred Eight dollars (\$2,052,408.00) to be used to conduct demolition and remediation of the Lake East Hospital site;


WHEREAS, the City of Painesville has received the Grant Agreement for funds to begin the Lake East Hospital project to remediate the property to a residential land use standard and address the needs of the community by creating a viable building site;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:**

SECTION I. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement with the Ohio Department of Development for Clean Ohio Revitalization Funds for the above-mentioned project.

SECTION II. This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate need to submit the necessary paperwork for the grant application to begin the project, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
