

RESOLUTION NO. 9-11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLIC RECREATION PURPOSES, SPECIFICALLY HUNTINGTON PARK IMPROVEMENTS, WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the State of Ohio Nature Works Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville desires financial assistance under the Nature Works Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio:

SECTION I: That the City of Painesville approves filing an application for financial assistance.

SECTION II: That the City Manager shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION III: That the City of Painesville does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project, which is Improvements to Huntington Park, and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Nature Works Program and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
