

RESOLUTION NO. 9-12


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION AND PUMP STATION IN THE SHAMROCK BUSINESS CENTER, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders, for a sanitary sewer extension and pump station in the Shamrock Business Center, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being that the construction must be completed to assure the continued development of the Shamrock Business Center to generate economic interest in the area, and therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
