


RESOLUTION NO. 10-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR WATERLINE REPLACEMENTS ON HOYT STREET, AVERY TERRACE, OAK STREET AND ADELAIDE AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I. That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for Waterline Replacements on Hoyt Street, Avery Terrace, Oak Street and Adelaide Avenue, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and for customers in Painesville Township served by our water system, the emergency being the immediate necessity to replace aging waterlines, the continued use of which could lead to frequent and costly repairs, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
