

RESOLUTION NO. 10-16

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF THOMAS V. RAPINI FOR THE PLACEMENT OF FARMLAND, LOCATED ON ELM STREET AND OAK STREET IN THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, IN AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Thomas V. Rapini are the owners of eleven (11) parcels on Oak Street totaling 11.6 acres, and two (2) parcels on Elm Street totaling 6.0 acres in the City of Painesville, said lands presently used for agricultural purposes, and known as Permanent Parcel Nos.:

WHEREAS, an application for renewal was filed with the Clerk of Council of the City of Painesville to place said lands in an "Agricultural District" pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 929.02.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio that:

SECTION I. That the Council of the City of Painesville hereby approved the renewal application of Thomas V. Rapini and for placement of certain parcels on Oak Street and Elm Street, as herein described, in an Agricultural District.

SECTION II. That this resolution shall become effective in the earliest period allowed by law.
