
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI VALLEY INTERNATIONAL TRUCK FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW 2011 INTERNATIONAL MODEL 7400 TANDEM TRUCK CHASSIS WITH 300 HP FOR THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT, WATER DIVISION, AT PRICES AND TERMS CONSISTENT WITH CURRENT CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Miami Valley International Truck for the purchase of a new 2011 International Model 7400 Tandem Truck Chassis with 300 HP, to include a 3600 gallon Aluminum Tank System with a Masport HXL 400 Water Cooler with Secondary and Oil Catch Muffler Installed for the Utilities Department, Water Division, at prices and terms consistent with the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program authorized by Ordinance No. 14-86.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to purchase this vehicle authorized in the 2010 Annual Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. 28-09 adopted December 21, 2009 which will allow City Personnel to haul alum sludge from the Water Plant to the Water Pollution Control Plant rather than contracting this service to an outside agency, thereby reducing Water Plant operational cost by approximately \$120,000.00, a year and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
