

RESOLUTION NO. 11 -14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN AIR FILTRATION/EXHAUST SYSTEM FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT, FIRE DIVISION OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO

Section I. That the City Manager be and he his hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders, for purchasing and installing a new air filtration/exhaust system to replace the present non-functioning system in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager..

Section II. That this resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the firefighters of the City of Painesville, The emergency being the necessity to replace a non-functioning filtration/exhaust system that will improve safety, eliminate known carcinogens from the work environment, and bring the fire department into compliance with NFPA standards, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.


