

RESOLUTION NO. 11-16


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE 2016 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM - PHASE 1, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That the City Manger be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, including any and all ensuing change orders, with the lowest and best bidder for the 2016 Road Improvement Program - Phase 1, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager, for the Engineering Department. The 2016 Road Improvement Program - Phase 1 includes the resurfacing of Courtland Street from Jackson Street to Prospect Street, Rockwood Drive from North State Street to Erie Street, Gillett Street from Luary Drive to Washington Street, Fern Drive from Mentor Avenue to Jackson Street, and Stage Avenue from the Grand River Railway tracks to Richmond Street. This project will consist of the planing of existing asphalt concrete, the overlaying of asphalt concrete, and pavement markings.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to repave various streets within the City in order to improve safety and decrease the costs of maintenance and repair along with associated labor costs and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
