

RESOLUTION NO. 12-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT, AND SUPPORTING SAID APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THE OHIO JOB READY SITES PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, The State of Ohio, Department of Development provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of developing speculative sites for future economic development opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville desires to participate by receiving financial assistance for the Painesville Industrial Site Development Project under the Ohio Jobs Ready Sites Program; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Painesville has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio Department of Development through the Jobs Ready Sites Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Painesville must direct and authorize the Site Improvement Manager to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, COUNTY OF LAKE:

**Section 1.** That the City Council authorizes the City Manager as the official representative (the "Site Improvement Project Manager") of the City of Painesville to file an application to participate in the State of Ohio Department of Development through the Jobs Ready Sites Program, and provide all information and documentation required in the application for submission.

**Section 2.** That the City Council hereby approves of filing an application for financial assistance under the Job Ready Sites Program.

**Section 3.** That the City Council hereby understands and agrees that participation in the program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

**Section 3.** That the City Council hereby commits itself to provide the required match investment, as described in the application.


**Section 4.** This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the need to file the application by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 deadline and, therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
