A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR REPAIRS TO THE PARKING GARAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The City of Painesville owns and operates a parking garage in Downtown Painesville for the benefit of the community; and


WHEREAS, the city desires to ensure the longevity and continued use of said facility by making various physical improvements to the structure that is over 35 years old. Now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders, for various structural repairs to the Parking Garage.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being need to insure that repairs are done during the appropriate weather to ensure maximum life expectancy and therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
