

RESOLUTION NO. 13-13


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLTION OF A PUMP, MOTOR, AND NECESSARY PIPING AT THE LOW SERVICE STATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY OHIO:


SECTION I. That the City Manager is herby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for purchase and installation of a pump, motor, and necessary piping at the Low Service Pump Station in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the City Manager.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and for the customers in Painesville Township served by our water system, the emergency being the immediate necessity to distribute water to consumers, increase energy efficiency, and improve the infrastructure, and therefore, this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon its passage.
