


RESOLUTION NO. 14-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR ASBESTOS ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION OF THE FORMER LAKEEAST HOSPITAL BUILDING LOCATED AT 10 EAST WASHINGTON STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders, for Asbestos Abatement and Demolition of the former LakeEast Hospital building located at 10 East Washington Street in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.


SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to first rid the building of asbestos, then demolish the building followed by clean-up of the site thereby preparing the land to be used in a more productive manner, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
