
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE FORD F-350 PICKUP TRUCK PLUS SELECTED APPURTENANCES, FOR THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT, ELECTRIC DIVISION, DISTRIBUTION SECTION AT PRICES AND TERMS CONSISTENT WITH CURRENT CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Valley Ford Truck Inc. for the purchase of one Ford Truck, Model F-350, plus selected appurtenances for the Utilities Department, Electric Division, Distribution Section at prices and terms consistent with the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program authorized by Ordinance No. 14-86, delivered price being \$25,497.20, plus \$18.50 for a 30 Day Tag and approximately \$48.00 delivery charge.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to purchase this vehicle authorized in the 2011 Annual Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. 21-10 adopted December 20, 2010 and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
