
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT/PURCHASE AGREEMENT TO UPGRADE THE CITY'S EXISTING NEC TELEPHONE SYSTEM, AT PRICES AND TERMS CONSISTENT WITH CURRENT CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:


**SECTION I:** That the City Manger be and she is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract/Purchase Agreement to upgrade the City's existing NEC Telephone System, at prices and terms consistent with the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program authorized by Ordinance No. 14-86.

**SECTION II:** That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to begin the systematic replacement of the City's telephone system equipment to improve communications and access to servers, particularly in emergency situations, authorized in the 2012 Annual Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. 7-12 adopted March 19, 2012, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
