

RESOLUTION NO. 15-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR COMMUNICATION IMPROVEMENTS BETWEEN THE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM'S PUMP STATIONS AND TANKS TO THE WATER PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a need to improve communication between the City's Water Distribution pump stations and tanks to the Water Plant; and

WHEREAS, a communications system will allow the Water Plant to monitor and control the pump stations and water tanks to improve reliability; and


WHEREAS, the improvements were approved by the City Council as part of the 2013 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY OHIO:

SECTION I. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for communication improvements between the Water Distribution system's pump station and tanks to the Water Plant, in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the City Manager.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and for its customers served by our water system, the emergency being the immediate necessity to improve the communications between the Water Distribution system's pump stations, tanks and the Water Plant, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
