

**RESOLUTION NO. 15 -16**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM LAKE COUNTY FY'16/17 COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO IMPROVE THE HOUSING STOCK BY ASSISTING RESIDENTS REPLACE DILAPIDATED OR LEAKING ROOFS IN THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Federal Grants Office administers financial assistance to improve a community's housing stock and for the purpose of addressing urgent community development needs through the Federal Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County's Federal Grant Office accepted applications for the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program through May 16, 2016 and the City of Painesville submitted an application to meet the deadline; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville wishes to submit an application for funding through the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program in order to address an identified need that is impacting the housing stock in Painesville – dilapidated roofs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville received twenty-eight (28) applications for this year's roof replacement program and anticipates completing eight (8) with the funding available in FY15/16; and

**WHEREAS**, funding through the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program will enable the City of Painesville to offer a roof replacement program to assist those residents that we were not able assist this year while improving the housing stock and relieving the financial stress on the homeowner; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute and file an application with the Lake County Federal Grant Office and to provide all information and necessary documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

**SECTION II:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant funding awarded by the Lake County Board of County Commissioners.

**SECTION III:** That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, and for the further need to submit the application and Resolution prior to review of the applications; and therefore, this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
