

RESOLUTION NO. 16-11


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS FOR THE YEAR 2011 PAVING PROGRAM and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION I:** That the City Manager be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders for the Year 2011 Paving Program that includes the resurfacing of a section of Jefferson Street and Nebraska Street. Alternate Bids will also be obtained for Munson Street and Gillett Street (south of Walnut Avenue).

**SECTION II:** That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the necessity to repair and resurface various streets within the boundaries of the City of Painesville under the City's ongoing Street Improvement Program, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
