

RESOLUTION NO. 16-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLIC RECREATION PURPOSES WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the State of Ohio Nature Works Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville desires financial assistance under the Nature Works Program to make improvements to Huntington Park as proposed in the 2010 master plan;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION I:** That the City Manager shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance through the Nature Works Program.


**SECTION II:** That the City of Painesville does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project at Huntington Park.

**SECTION III:** That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and in order to ensure that the Nature Works grant application is submitted in a timely manner; and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
