

**RESOLUTION NO. 16 -16**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM LAKE COUNTY FY'16/17 COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO MAKE RESTROOM IMPROVEMENTS AT KIWANIS RECREATION PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Federal Grants Office administers financial assistance for the purpose of addressing urgent community development needs through the Federal Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County's Federal Grant Office accepted applications for FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program through May 16, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Painesville wishes to submit an application for funding through the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program in order to enable the Department of Recreation and Public Lands to make application for funds to make restroom improvements at Kiwanis Recreation Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will utilize these funds to upgrade and remodel the main restroom facility at Kiwanis Recreation Park and further the objectives identified in the Department of Recreation and Public Land's Comprehensive Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute and file an application with the Lake County Federal Grant Office and to provide all information and necessary documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

**SECTION II:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant funding awarded by the Lake County Board of County Commissioners.


