


RESOLUTION NO. 17-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR LEXINGTON AVENUE STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, including any and all ensuing change orders, with the lowest and best bidder for Lexington Avenue Storm Sewer Improvements, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.


SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to upgrade existing and aging Storm Sewers prior to Roadway Reconstruction, which will improve drainage and eliminate flooding in the area thereby reducing street maintenance, labor and repair costs and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
