

RESOLUTION NO. 17-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS FOR THE BANK STREET EMBANKMENT STABILIZATION, WITHOUT FORMAL ADVERTISING AND BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Bank Street embankment adjacent to the Grand River has been weakening to the point of collapse and the landslide across from 318 Bank Street and continuing for 150 feet has deteriorated to the point that stabilization and repair to the area is critical to the continued use of the area creating an emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that soil nail stabilization is the preferred economical stabilizing technology; and


WHEREAS, the City has identified limited contractors eligible to operate this technology and, therefore, will request competitive quotations for the immediate completion of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO, NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the lowest and best contractor, for emergency embankment stabilization of 150 feet of Bank Street, without formal advertising and bidding in accordance with the provision of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to alleviate ongoing deterioration of the embankment and to prevent possible collapse into the Grand River, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
