

RESOLUTION NO. 17 -16

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM LAKE COUNTY FY'16/17 COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO ADDRESS THE NEEDED CURB RAMP IMPROVEMENTS ALONG RICHMOND STREET IN ORDER TO BE COMPLIANT WITH ADA REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Lake County Federal Grants Office administers financial assistance to improve a community's housing stock and for the purpose of addressing urgent community development needs through the Federal Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, Lake County's Federal Grant Office accepted applications for the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program through May 16, 2016 and the City of Painesville submitted the application to meet the deadline; and

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville wishes to submit an application for funding through the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program in order to address the need to install curb ramp improvements within the public right-of-way along Richmond Street in order to be compliant with ADA regulations; and

WHEREAS, funding through the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant Program will enable the City of Painesville to make improvements to the City sidewalks and street crossings along Richmond Street in order to improve accessibility for people with disabilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio:

SECTION I: That the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute and file an application with the Lake County Federal Grant Office and to provide all information and necessary documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION II: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept the FY'16/17 Community Development Block Grant funding awarded by the Lake County Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION III: That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, and for the further need to submit the application and Resolution prior to review of the applications; and therefore, this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
