
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CONCORD TOWNSHIP/CONCORD FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE A 1991 SUTPHEN AERIAL FROM BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP/BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT AND TO HAVE NECESSARY MAINTENANCE ON SAID AERIAL PERFORMED PRIOR TO PLACING IT INTO SERVICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Concord Township/Concord Fire Department for the joint purchase of one 1991 Sutphen Aerial for a total cost not more than \$85,000 with the cost of necessary maintenance estimated at \$20,000 as said agreement shall spell out such critical items to ensure the on-going maintenance and operations of the vehicle.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville and residents of neighboring communities also assisted by our firefighters, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide the City with a longer, more effective and safer platform from which to fight fires, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
