


RESOLUTION NO. 21-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE RESURFACING OF CEDARBROOK DRIVE FROM CHESTNUT STREET TO SOUTHINGTON BOULEVARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, including any and all ensuing change orders, with the lowest and best bidder for the Resurfacing of Cedarbrook Drive from Chestnut Street to Southington Boulevard, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.


SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide motorists using Cedarbrook Drive a new roadway to replace an aging surface, thereby increasing safe driving conditions in this highly traveled area and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
