
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, TO INCLUDE ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE RECONDUCTORING OF APPROXIMATELY 2.1 MILES OF CIRCUIT (H2) FROM MIDDLE RIDGE ROAD TO THE SITE OF THE WIND TURBINES ON ANTIOCH ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION I.** That the City Manger is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder(s), to include any and all ensuing change orders, for the reconductoring of approximately 2.1 miles of the H2 circuit from Middleridge Road to the site of the wind turbines on Antioch Road.

**SECTION II.** That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the necessity to reconductor a distribution circuit (H2) for the wind turbine project in order to allow for timely installation and operation of the wind turbines and to improve the City of Painesville's Electric System reliability, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
