

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME) RELATING TO ARTICLES 23 (HOLIDAYS) AND 26 (VACATION), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville and AFSCME entered into a three-year contract effective April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the contract stipulated a wage re-opener in the third year of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City met with AFSCME in the third year of the wage re-opener and desires to resolve the issues involved with the wage reopener provision by agreeing to a 0% wage increase and modifying current Holiday and Vacation contract provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY OHIO:

SECTION I. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with AFSCME amending said contract to provide for a Christmas Eve Holiday and to modify Vacation Leave to allow AFSCME employees to use the time as it is accrued.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being that the immediate passage is necessary to establish the amended terms of the AFSCME Contract and; therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.


