

RESOLUTION NO. 28-11


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT AMBULANCE CHASSIS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, including any and all ensuing change orders, with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase and installation of a Replacement Chassis for One Ambulance in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to replace and aged and worn chassis that will improve safety and decrease costs of maintenance, repair and associated labor costs, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
