

RESOLUTION NO. 28-12

**A RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO THE RENEWAL OF
THE 367 NORTH STATE STREET D-5/D-6 LIQUOR
PERMIT TO TONY'S SUBWAY INN, PAINESVILLE,
OHIO, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:


SECTION I. That the City Council, as legislative authority of the City of Painesville, objects to the renewal of the liquor permit issued under provisions of the Ohio Revised Code to Tony's Subway Inn, 367 North State Street, Painesville, Lake County, Ohio for the reasons that said applicant has operated its liquor permit business in a manner that demonstrates a disregard for the laws, regulations and local ordinances of this State; and/or is so located with respect to the neighborhood that substantial interference with public decency, sobriety, peace or good order would result from the issuance, renewal, transfer of ownership of the permit and operation thereunder by the applicant; and further requests a hearing on same.

SECTION II. That the City Council hereby requests said hearing be held within the County Seat of Lake County as permitted by Ohio Revised Code §4303.271(B).

SECTION III. That the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control, Reynoldsburg, Ohio, in order that said Department may make the necessary arrangements for a hearing on this objection to the renewal of a liquor permit.

SECTION IV. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the necessity to immediately object to the renewal of the aforementioned liquor permit so as to comply with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code §4303.271; and therefore, this Resolutions shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
