

RESOLUTION NO. 28-14

**ESTABLISHING
T&T BAKERY'S ITALIAN BREAD AS
THE OFFICIAL BREAD OF PAINESVILLE**

WHEREAS, each local business in Painesville is part of the City's identity who make an impact in the community; and

WHEREAS, in 1971, John Terriaco and his wife, Evalina opened T&T Bakery located at 252 East Erie Street, the business that he and his family have been running for the past 43 years; and

WHEREAS, the bakery has earned a devoted following from the community with its authentic Italian bread, mouth watering doughnuts and rich cassata cakes; and

WHEREAS, John Terriaco emigrated from Italy to Painesville, bringing his father's Italian bread recipe to our fine City; and

WHEREAS, according to the bakery manager, Felix Terriaco, "My father never wanted to go into business with the intentions of getting rich off a customer. He just wanted to make something good that everybody liked and be fair with the price"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That this Council, for itself, and on behalf of the Administration and citizens of the City of Painesville, hereby establishes T&T Bakery's Italian Bread as The Official Bread Of Painesville. We hereby recognize T&T Bakery, and express appreciation for their many years as a dedicated business in the City of Painesville, providing families and the greater Painesville community with authentic Italian baked goods, and for its continued presence and investment in this community and the region.

SECTION II. That this resolution shall be entered upon the permanent record of the City of Painesville, and a certified copy hereof shall be presented to T&T Bakery.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
