A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE  
AGREEMENT WITH LAKE COUNTY BOARD OF  
COMMISSIONERS FOR USE OF THE 800 MHZ RADIO  
SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville is currently participating in the use of the county wide 800 MHz Radio System; and

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville Police and Fire Division desire to continue to participate in the 800 MHz radio system as upgraded and improved.

WHEREAS, the County has requested participation in the cost of acquisition and installation of the system backbone based on a pro rata share of the use of the equipment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to enter into an purchase agreement with the Lake County Board of Commissioners for the use of the 800 MHz Radio System.

Section 2. This Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the need enter into the new agreement prior to the expiration of the existing agreement to ensure the safety of the residents of the city and, therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
