

RESOLUTION NO. 32-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, TO INCLUDE ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE OVERPASS OVER THE CSX RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND THE EXTENSION OF BROOKSTONE BOULEVARD, AND ALL RELATED APPURTENANCES THERETO, WITHIN SHAMROCK BOULEVARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville has established a program to improve the economic viability of the City and in this connection has prepared plans and specifications for the Construction of a Shamrock Boulevard bridge overpass, and the extension of Brookstone Boulevard, and


WHEREAS, in regard to the designated project it is necessary to adjoin a Bridge Overpass to the existing roadway and extend Brookstone Boulevard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, OHIO:

**SECTION I:** That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders, for the construction of a bridge over the CSX railroad tracks in the vicinity of Shamrock Boulevard and extend Brookstone Boulevard, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.

**SECTION II:** That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville the emergency being the immediate necessity to construct this bridge connection to Brookstone Boulevard, a critical link to the safety of the area and the continuation of the development of the Shamrock Business Center, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
