


RESOLUTION NO. 33-11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR ELM STREET WATER LINE REPLACEMENT FROM THE SOUTHSIDE OF SR 2 TO THE LIGHTHOUSE POINTE SUBDIVISION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


SECTION I. That the City Manager be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for Elm Street Water Line Replacement from the Southside of SR 2 to the Lighthouse Pointe Subdivision, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manager.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the necessity to replace aged water lines in this section of the City of Painesville that have experienced numerous breaks and water discoloration that would best be avoided by replacement and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
