

RESOLUTION NO. 34-12


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF TWO ANAEROBIC DIGESTER SLUDGE HEATERS AT THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I: That the City Manager be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, including any and all ensuing change orders, for the purchase and installation of Two Anaerobic Digester Sludge Heaters at the City of Painesville Water Pollution Control Plant, in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the City Manager.

SECTION II: That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the necessity to replace sludge heaters installed in 1978, which have had recent equipment failures, with energy efficient sludge heaters that use methane gas produced by the anaerobic digestion process and reduces heating cost and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
