RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITY OF PROVIDING SENIOR SERVICES WITH THE PAINESVILLE AREA SENIOR CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the City of Painesville, (the "City") and the Painesville Area Senior Center (the "Senior Center") have negotiated and now intend to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for the City to assume the responsibility of providing senior services and the future operation of the Painesville Area Senior Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio:

SECTION I. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding to assume the responsibility of providing senior services and the operation of the Painesville Area Senior Center.


