

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE GRANT FROM LAKE COUNTY FY'12 COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Painesville submitted an initial application in May of 2011 to the Lake County FY'12 Community Development Grant Program for funds to develop State Street Park; and

WHEREAS, Lake County's Federal Grants Office accepted that grant application and committed to provide assistance in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for development of State Street Park using FY'12 Community Development Grant Program funds; and

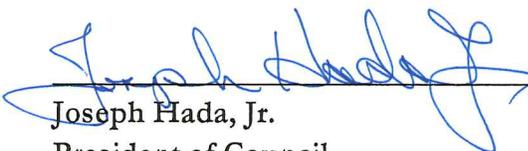
WHEREAS, the City of Painesville has agreed to match said grant with Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) budgeted for State Street Park improvements and in-kind contributions, specifically the labor and equipment to perform the necessary work associated with the park improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, LAKE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I. That Rita C. McMahon, City Manager, is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement with Lake County's Federal Grants Office for the FY'12 Community Development Grant Program for the State Street Park Development Project.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate need to submit the necessary documentation to begin the project this fall to insure completion by the August 31, 2012 deadline, and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
