


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, INCLUDING ANY AND ALL ENSUING CHANGE ORDERS, FOR MODIFICATION TO THE INTAKE STRUCTURE AT THE WATER PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That the City Manger be and she is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into a contact with the lowest and best bidder, to include any and all ensuing change orders, for modification to the intake structure at the Painesville Water Plant, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the City Manger.

SECTION II. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to make modifications to the intake structure to avoid restrictions of flow due to frazzle ice, sand and debris to allow for more efficient production at the Water Treatment Plant and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
