

RESOLUTION NO. 37-11

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO  
ESTABLISH THE CONCORD-PAINESVILLE JOINT  
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT WATER  
RATES PURSUANT TO THE EXISTING JEDD  
AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the City and Concord township have entered into an agreement which established a Joint Economic Development District (JEDD) to encourage economic development and investment within SR 44/Auburn Rd and Crile corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the JEDD agreement requires that the city of Painesville provide water service to the JEDD area at a discount from the rates charged to other customers within the Concord area; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that the acceptable discount is 5% less than the outside rate established by Section 933.19 of the Painesville Code of 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recognizes the important financial contribution the JEDD area provides to the fiscal stability of the city and the region.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Council hereby establishes the JEDD water rate discount at 5% pursuant to Section 7 (a) of the JEDD agreement.

**SECTION 2.** The Resolution is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate need to comply with the requirements of the JEDD agreement and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
