

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL 1.47 MILL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION AND REQUESTING LAKE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE CITY AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY A FIRE LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Painesville, Lake County, State of Ohio finds that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the City and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department for the City of Painesville; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, in order to submit the question of levying an additional 1.47 mill tax pursuant to Section 5705.19(I) of the Ohio Revised Code, Council must request the Lake County Auditor to certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the City and (ii) the dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by the police levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of the resolution of Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Ohio Revised Code authoring its submission to the electors, and requesting certificate, the Lake County Auditor is to verify the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAINESVILLE, COUNTY OF LAKE STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. The Council declares that it is a necessity to levy an additional five (5) years 1.47 mill ad valorem property tax in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department for the City of Painesville on the November 5, 2013 election as authorized by Section 5705.19(I) of the Ohio Revised Code. If approved the 1.47 mill tax would be first levied in tax year 2013, for collection in first collection in calendar year 2014.

Section 2. The Council requests that the Lake County Auditor certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the City and (ii) the dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by the 1.47 mill tax fire levy as specified in Section 1.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Lake County.

Section 4. That this Resolution is passed as an emergency measure for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Painesville, the emergency being the immediate necessity to timely file with the Lake County Auditor in order that the question of a tax levy may be submitted to the electorate, provide it is approved by Council and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
